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4. Green Campus Measures

4.1 Clean and Healthy Campus

- Emphasis on cleanliness in classrooms, corridors, laboratories, library, and common areas
- Regular cleanliness and beautification activities

- Placement of waste bins at strategic locations
 - Sensitization of students and staff regarding hygiene and civic responsibility
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4.2 Waste Management

- Encouragement of basic waste segregation wherever feasible
 - Discouraging littering and irresponsible disposal
 - Reduction in the use of single-use plastic items
 - Awareness programmes on responsible waste habits
 - Periodic cleanliness drives with student involvement
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4.3 Energy Conservation

- Promotion of careful use of lights, fans, computers, and electrical equipment
 - Switch-off practice when rooms are not in use
 - Maximum utilization of natural light and ventilation
 - Monitoring to avoid unnecessary consumption of electricity
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4.4 Water Conservation

- Promotion of responsible use of water by all stakeholders
- Regular inspection to prevent leakage and wastage
- Awareness through notices and discussions
- Proper monitoring of drinking water and washroom facilities

4.5 Environmental Awareness Activities

The College shall encourage:

- Observance of environment-related days
 - Student talks, poster making, and discussions on sustainability
 - Plantation and nature-related activities wherever possible
 - Community awareness and outreach programmes

6.2 Faculty and Staff

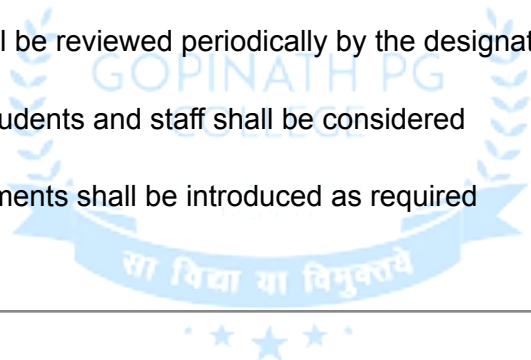
- Motivate students toward eco-friendly behaviour
