



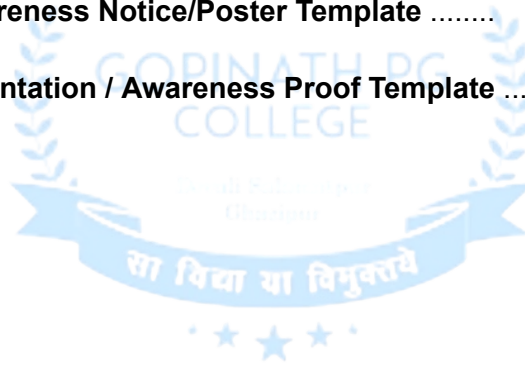

ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

(In line with UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 & UGC Circulars, 2025)

1. PREAMBLE

Gopinath PG College, Salamatpur, Uttar Pradesh is committed to providing a **safe, disciplined, inclusive, and learner-centric academic environment** where every student is treated with dignity and respect. The institution firmly believes that ragging, in any form, is a serious violation of human rights and institutional discipline, and it adversely affects the physical, psychological, and emotional well-being of students.

The College adopts a **zero-tolerance approach towards ragging** and undertakes all necessary preventive, corrective, and punitive measures to ensure that students—particularly newly admitted learners—are able to pursue their education in an atmosphere free from fear, coercion, humiliation, or harassment.

This Anti-Ragging Policy serves as a comprehensive framework for:

- Preventing incidents of ragging,
- Creating awareness among students and stakeholders,
- Establishing institutional mechanisms for monitoring and redressal, and
- Ensuring strict disciplinary action against those found guilty.

The policy reflects the institution's commitment to **ethical conduct, student welfare, campus safety, and holistic development**, and is binding on all members of the college community.

2. APPLICABILITY

This Anti-Ragging Policy is applicable to:

1. **All students** enrolled in Gopinath PG College, Salamatpur, Uttar Pradesh, including undergraduate, postgraduate, and any other programmes offered by the institution.
2. **All academic and non-academic spaces**, whether owned, managed, or used by the College, including but not limited to:
 - Classrooms, laboratories, libraries, seminar halls
 - Hostels, common rooms, corridors, washrooms
 - Playgrounds, sports facilities, and activity areas
 - Canteens, cafeterias, parking areas, and transport facilities
 - Offices and administrative blocks
3. **All off-campus locations** where students represent or are connected with the College, such as:
 - Educational tours, field visits, internships, and training programmes
 - Cultural, sports, and co-curricular activities
 - Any accommodation or facility arranged or recommended by the institution
4. **All forms of interaction among students**, including:
 - Face-to-face interactions
 - Written communication
 - Digital and online platforms, including social media, messaging applications, emails, and any other electronic medium

This policy is **binding on every student** from the date of admission until the completion of their academic association with the institution, and violation of its provisions will invite disciplinary action as prescribed by the College.

3. DEFINITION OF RAGGING

For the purpose of this policy, **ragging** refers to **any conduct, whether by an individual or a group of students**, that causes or is likely to cause **physical harm, psychological distress, emotional discomfort, humiliation, fear, or degradation** to another student, particularly a newly admitted student.

Ragging includes, but is not limited to, the following acts:

1. Verbal and Non-Verbal Abuse

- Teasing, mocking, taunting, insulting, or using offensive language
- Making derogatory remarks related to appearance, background, language, gender, caste, religion, or personal identity
- Threatening or intimidating behaviour

2. Physical Acts

- Forcing physical activities causing discomfort or injury
- Pushing, hitting, restraining, or any form of physical assault
- Any action that violates personal safety or bodily integrity

3. Psychological and Emotional Harassment

- Acts that create fear, stress, anxiety, or mental trauma
- Social isolation, exclusion, or manipulation
- Undermining a student's self-confidence, dignity, or sense of belonging

4. Compulsion and Coercion

- Forcing a student to perform acts that are embarrassing, degrading, or against their will

- Imposing tasks, punishments, or rituals as a condition for acceptance or inclusion
- Pressuring students to disclose personal information or perform inappropriate acts

5. Academic Disruption

- Preventing or disturbing students from attending classes, laboratories, examinations, or academic activities
- Interfering with study routines or academic progress

6. Financial Exploitation

- Demanding money, gifts, food, or services
- Forcing students to bear expenses against their will

7. Sexual Misconduct

- Any unwelcome verbal, non-verbal, or physical conduct of a sexual nature
- Inappropriate gestures, comments, or physical contact

8. Cyber and Online Ragging

- Harassment through social media, messaging platforms, emails, or online forums
- Sharing of offensive content, images, or messages
- Online threats, impersonation, or public shaming

Any act falling under the above categories—**whether committed within or outside the campus**—shall be treated as ragging and dealt with strictly under this policy.

4. PREVENTIVE MEASURES

Gopinath PG College, Salamatpur, Uttar Pradesh adopts a **preventive and participatory approach** to eliminate ragging by creating awareness, ensuring vigilance, and fostering a culture of mutual respect and responsibility. The following measures shall be implemented on a continuous basis:

4.1 Awareness and Sensitization

- Display of **anti-ragging messages and posters** at prominent locations across the campus.
- Orientation and induction programmes for newly admitted students highlighting:
 - Institutional values
 - Student rights and responsibilities
 - Consequences of involvement in ragging
- Awareness sessions for senior students focusing on positive peer interaction and leadership.

4.2 Student Support and Mentoring

- Establishment of a **structured mentoring system** wherein senior students guide and support freshers under institutional supervision.
- Availability of **counselling support** for students experiencing stress, anxiety, or adjustment issues.
- Regular interaction between faculty mentors and students to ensure early identification of concerns.

4.3 Monitoring and Supervision

- Formation of vigilance teams to conduct:
 - Surprise checks in sensitive areas
 - Regular rounds during academic hours and events
- Increased supervision during:
 - Admission period
 - Initial weeks of the academic session
 - Cultural, sports, and co-curricular activities

4.4 Infrastructure-Based Prevention

- Installation and maintenance of **CCTV surveillance** in key locations, subject to privacy norms.
- Adequate lighting and security arrangements across campus premises.

4.5 Stakeholder Involvement

- Active involvement of faculty members, administrative staff, hostel wardens, and student representatives in prevention efforts.
- Encouragement of students to report concerns **without fear of retaliation**, ensuring confidentiality and protection.

Through these preventive measures, the College aims to **create a welcoming, secure, and fear-free campus environment** that promotes academic focus, personal growth, and healthy peer relationships.

5. INSTITUTIONAL MECHANISMS

To ensure effective implementation of this Anti-Ragging Policy, Gopinath PG College, Salamatpur, Uttar Pradesh has established **structured institutional mechanisms** with clearly defined responsibilities and reporting systems.

5.1 Anti-Ragging Committee

An **Anti-Ragging Committee** shall function as the apex body for policy oversight and decision-making.

Composition:

- Chairperson: Principal of the College
- Senior faculty members
- Representatives from non-teaching staff
- Student representatives (including freshers and senior students)
- Parent representatives

- External members from the local community, as deemed appropriate by the institution

Functions:

- Oversee the effective implementation of the Anti-Ragging Policy
- Review preventive strategies and campus safety measures
- Examine reported cases and recommend appropriate action
- Promote a culture of discipline, respect, and student welfare
- Submit periodic reports to the college administration

5.2 Anti-Ragging Squad

An **Anti-Ragging Squad** shall be constituted by the Principal for active monitoring and immediate intervention.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Conduct regular and surprise inspections across the campus
- Maintain heightened vigilance during critical periods
- Respond promptly to complaints or suspected incidents
- Report observations and incidents to the Anti-Ragging Committee
- Act as a first-response body to prevent escalation

5.3 Mentoring and Student Support System

The College shall operate a **Mentoring and Student Support System** to facilitate smooth transition and integration of new students.

Key Features:

- Allocation of senior student mentors under faculty supervision
- Reasonable mentor–mentee ratio to ensure effective guidance

- Regular interaction sessions to address academic, emotional, and social concerns
- Promotion of healthy peer bonding and positive campus engagement

These institutional mechanisms work collaboratively to ensure **early detection, timely intervention, and strict action**, reinforcing the College's commitment to a safe and supportive learning environment.

6. DUTIES OF STUDENTS

Every student of Gopinath PG College, Salamatpur, Uttar Pradesh is expected to uphold the values of **discipline, mutual respect, and responsible behaviour**. In this regard, students shall adhere to the following duties:

1. Compliance with Policy

- Read, understand, and strictly comply with the provisions of this Anti-Ragging Policy.
- Submit the prescribed anti-ragging declaration/undertaking at the time of admission.

2. Prohibition of Ragging

- Refrain from engaging in any form of ragging, whether individually or in groups.
- Avoid encouraging, supporting, or remaining silent spectators to acts of ragging.

3. Respectful Conduct

- Treat fellow students with dignity, courtesy, and sensitivity at all times.
- Foster an atmosphere of inclusion and cooperation within the campus.

4. Reporting Responsibility

- Promptly report any incident or suspicion of ragging to:
 - Faculty members
 - Mentors

- Anti-Ragging Squad or Committee
- College authorities
- Cooperate fully during inquiries or investigations.

5. Non-Retaliation Assurance

- Students reporting ragging in good faith shall not face any academic or personal disadvantage.

Failure to comply with these duties shall be considered a serious breach of institutional discipline and will invite strict action under this policy.

7. DUTIES OF FACULTY AND STAFF

Faculty members and staff of Gopinath PG College, Salamatpur, Uttar Pradesh play a crucial role in maintaining a safe, disciplined, and supportive campus environment. They shall discharge the following responsibilities with diligence and sensitivity:

1. Vigilance and Supervision

- Remain alert to student behaviour within classrooms, corridors, common areas, and other campus spaces.
- Identify and respond promptly to any signs of intimidation, harassment, or misconduct.

2. Immediate Intervention

- Intervene without delay in situations where ragging is suspected or observed.
- Report incidents to the appropriate institutional authority for further action.

3. Student Guidance and Support

- Provide guidance and counselling to students, particularly freshers, to help them adjust to the academic and social environment.
- Encourage open communication and build trust so students feel safe to report concerns.

4. Role of Hostel Wardens and Supervisors

- Conduct regular inspections and interactions with resident students.
- Pay special attention to the well-being and safety of newly admitted students.
- Maintain records of visits and observations where applicable.

5. Cooperation in Institutional Processes

- Assist the Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad during inquiries or investigations.
- Participate in awareness programmes, mentoring initiatives, and training sessions related to student welfare.

Negligence or failure to perform these duties may attract administrative action as per institutional norms.

8. DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Any student found guilty of ragging, after due inquiry by the competent institutional authority, shall be subject to **strict disciplinary action**. The nature and severity of the punishment shall depend on the gravity of the offence and may include one or more of the following measures:

1. Academic Penalties

- Written warning and undertaking for minor violations
- Suspension from attending classes for a specified period
- Withholding of internal assessment, examination results, or academic privileges
- Debarment from academic activities, competitions, or institutional representations

2. Residential and Campus Restrictions

- Suspension or expulsion from hostel facilities
- Restriction from accessing specific campus facilities or participating in events

3. Administrative Actions

- Cancellation of admission
- Rustication from the institution for one or more academic semesters
- Expulsion from the College with permanent removal from rolls

4. Legal Action

- In cases involving serious physical, psychological, or sexual harm, the College may initiate or support appropriate legal proceedings as per applicable law.

5. Collective Responsibility

- When ragging is committed by a group, **collective disciplinary action** may be taken against all involved, including those who abetted or concealed the act.

All disciplinary actions shall be taken in accordance with **principles of natural justice**, ensuring fairness, confidentiality, and timely resolution.

9. COMPLAINT REDRESSAL MECHANISM

Gopinath PG College, Salamatpur, Uttar Pradesh ensures a **safe, transparent, and confidential system** for reporting and addressing incidents related to ragging. The College is committed to prompt action and protection of complainants.

1. Designated Nodal Officer

- The College shall appoint a **Nodal Officer (Anti-Ragging)** responsible for receiving complaints and coordinating necessary action.
- The name and contact details of the Nodal Officer shall be displayed prominently on the college notice boards and website.

2. Modes of Complaint Submission

Complaints related to ragging may be reported through:

- Direct communication with faculty members, mentors, hostel wardens, or administrative staff
- Submission to the Anti-Ragging Squad or Committee
- Written or oral complaint to the Principal or designated authority
- Institutional grievance or helpdesk mechanisms, where available

3. Confidentiality and Protection

- The identity of the complainant shall be kept confidential to the extent possible.
- No student shall be subjected to victimization, retaliation, or discrimination for reporting ragging in good faith.

4. Timely Inquiry and Action

- All complaints shall be acknowledged and examined promptly.

- A fair inquiry shall be conducted, and appropriate action shall be initiated without undue delay.
 - Interim measures may be taken to ensure the safety and well-being of the affected student(s).

The College encourages students to report incidents at the earliest to enable effective resolution and to maintain a safe campus environment.

10. DECLARATION

By seeking admission to and continuing their studies at **Gopinath PG College, Salamatpur, Uttar Pradesh**, every student, along with their parent or guardian, **acknowledges and agrees** to abide by the provisions of this Anti-Ragging Policy in letter and spirit.

The College affirms its commitment to maintaining a campus environment that is **safe, respectful, and conducive to learning**. Any violation of this policy shall be treated as a serious act of misconduct and will invite **strict disciplinary and/or legal action**, as deemed appropriate by the competent institutional authority.

This policy shall come into effect from the date of its approval and shall remain **binding on all students** throughout their association with the institution.

Constitution of Anti-Ragging Squad

1. PREAMBLE & PURPOSE

Gopinath PG College, Salamatpur, Uttar Pradesh is committed to ensuring a **safe, dignified, and student-friendly academic environment**. As part of its proactive approach to student welfare and campus discipline, the College constitutes an **Anti-Ragging Squad** as an operational and vigilance-based body.

The Anti-Ragging Squad functions as the **first-level preventive and responsive mechanism** to monitor, deter, and immediately address any behaviour that compromises student safety, dignity, or mental well-being. The Squad works in coordination with institutional authorities to ensure **early detection, prompt intervention, and systematic reporting**.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD

The Anti-Ragging Squad shall function with the following objectives:

- To maintain a **safe, respectful, and inclusive campus atmosphere** for all students.
- To exercise **active vigilance** in areas and periods vulnerable to ragging.
- To act as a **first-response team** in cases of reported or suspected ragging.
- To discourage misconduct through **visible presence and monitoring**.
- To promote **positive peer interaction, discipline, and institutional values**.
- To ensure **fact-based reporting and documentation** for institutional review and action.

3. CONSTITUTION OF THE SQUAD

The Anti-Ragging Squad shall be constituted by the Principal/Director and shall include a balanced representation of academic, administrative, and student stakeholders.

Composition:

- **Senior Faculty Member** – Convener
- **Faculty Member** – Member
- **Administrative / Non-Teaching Staff** – Member
- **Hostel Warden / Transport In-charge** – Member
- **Student Mentor / Peer Leader** – Member

The composition may be revised periodically to ensure effectiveness and coverage.

4. FUNCTIONS & DUTIES OF THE SQUAD

The Anti-Ragging Squad shall perform the following duties:

- Conduct **regular and surprise checks** in:
 - Hostels and residential areas
 - Classrooms and laboratories
 - Canteens, common areas, corridors
 - Transport facilities and entry/exit points
- Monitor student gatherings, cultural events, sports activities, and informal interactions.
- Remain especially active during:
 - Admission periods

- Initial months of the academic session
 - Institutional events and celebrations
 - **Receive, record, and immediately report** any instance or suspicion of ragging to the Anti-Ragging Committee.
 - Ensure **timely intervention** to prevent escalation of incidents.
 - Maintain a **daily observation and vigilance log** during critical periods (particularly the first three months of the academic session).
 - Assist in **student sensitization and awareness activities** related to discipline, mutual respect, and healthy campus culture.

5. REPORTING & ACCOUNTABILITY

- The Anti-Ragging Squad shall function under the **overall supervision of the Anti-Ragging Committee.**
 - All findings, observations, and reports shall be:
 - Reviewed by the Committee
 - Placed before the Principal/Director for necessary action
 - Corrective and preventive measures shall be implemented based on squad reports.
 - **Records of squad activities**, including inspection logs and reports, shall be:
 - Properly documented
 - Preserved as part of institutional records
 - Made available for internal review and assessment purposes



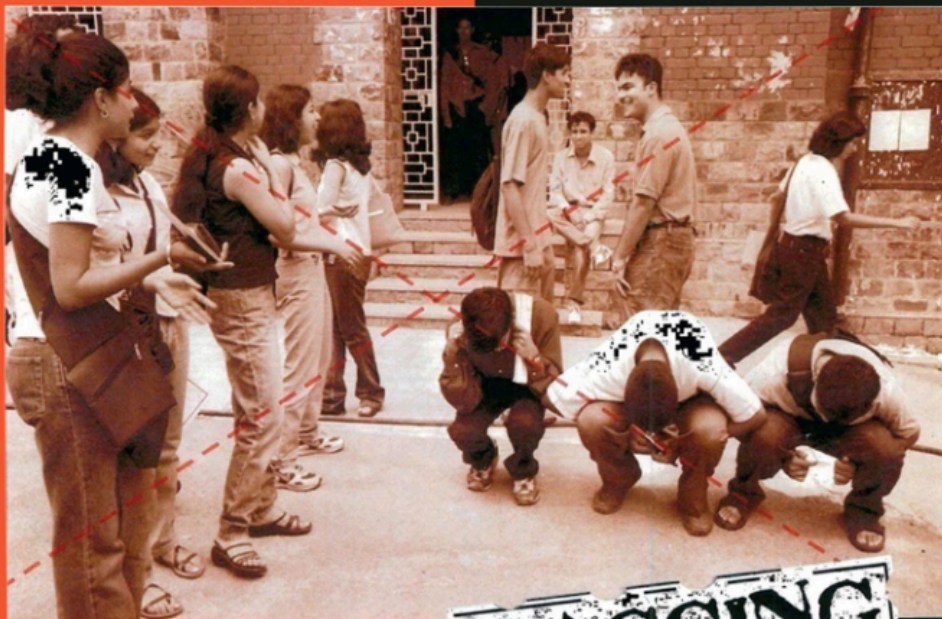
